RTI is located on the Salem Alliance Church campus in downtown Salem, OR.

Nestled within the Willamette Valley, RTI is situated in an ideal location just an hour from Portland, the mountains, and the ocean. Just north of the campus, students have bike and walk access to a number of theaters, restaurants, shopping centers, and Riverfront Park.



# Academic Programs

RTI enables students who are called to full-time, vocational ministry to earn a fully-accredited, 4 year Bachelor of Science degree in partnership with Crown College.

# Degree Components

## General Education Courses (21 credits)

*\*\*These credits are transferred to RTI. You can complete these at a local community college.*

## RTI Bible and Theology Courses (74 credits)

*\*\*These credits are taken on campus with your cohort on Tuesdays and Thursdays.*

## Crown College Online Courses (30 credits)

*\*\*These upper division courses are taken your junior and senior year online.*



*Staff will provide academic advising throughout your time at RTI.*



# Student Life

## Church & Community

RTI students are encouraged to engage in community at Salem Alliance Church. You will have opportunities beginning in your freshmen year to serve in church ministry, outreach ministries, social businesses or other local non-profits. You will build significant relationships with your peers and professors as class sizes are intimate allowing for richer discussions.

While RTI is unable to offer traditional dorm living, our staff will work with you to secure housing. Many of our students choose to share an apartment or home.



# Cohort Culture

---

Reach Training Institute is designed around a **cohort model**. When you enter RTI as a freshmen, you will follow a schedule of courses and practicums with your cohort over the next 4 years.

The cohort experience allows for RTI students to grow in **close relationships** with one another and prepare for a future career in vocational ministry. The experiences learned in your RTI cohort will develop your skills in **teamwork** and **collaboration**.
